Mark is national program manager of Green Steps, a triple-award winning program (Banksia Award, Premier’s Sustainability Award and United Nations Association of Australia Environment Day Award) which leads organisational change by training tertiary students and professionals to implement sustainability in their workplaces.

Mark is also lead trainer for Sustainability Victoria's ResourceSmart program, engaging over 300 Victorian government agencies, hospitals and tertiary institutions in training for organisational sustainability.

Mark has practical experience in leading change in roles with the Monash University Green Office program, Environment Victoria, the Victorian Office of the Commissioner for Environmental Sustainability and the Gould League; along with a Masters in Environmental Science and a Cert IV in Workplace Training and Assessment.
